

ARTICLE OF THE MONTH -Toilet Training Tips for Parents-

Toilet training, also known as nappy or potty training, is a big step in your child's development. At Hope Childcare, we're here to support both you and your child through this journey. Whether you are considering toileting, in the process, or need further assistance, here are some helpful tips and advice to make toilet training a smooth process.

When to Start

Every child is different, so there's no set age to start toilet training. Generally, children show signs of readiness around 2 years old, but some may be ready earlier. We follow your child's cues and readiness before starting. Having said that, toilet training is based on the child's developmental level and their own readiness to start, rather than their age.

Signs of Readiness

If your child shows interest in using the toilet or talks about it, they might be ready. Other signs include showing discomfort in wet or soiled nappies or asking to be changed. Follow your child's lead and make toilet time fun!

Skip the Potty

It is best practice to go straight to using the toilet instead of using a potty. This helps avoid confusion for your child. To help avoid any delays and help your child with independence skills, the toilet should be easily accessible with a stool or toilet insert for safety. To help your child sit for a couple of minutes on the toilet, you can read a wipeable book, play "I spy", etc.

Dealing with Setbacks and Toileting Accidents

Toilet training isn't always smooth sailing. Setbacks and accidents are expected, so be patient and supportive. Changes in routine or life events such as getting a new sibling can cause regressions, but with time and encouragement, your child will get there.

Helpful Tips for Children with Special Needs:

- 1) Familiarize with the Bathroom: Introduce the bathroom gradually using books, videos, or practice runs fully clothed to make it familiar and comfortable. It may take longer for some children to be comfortable with it, but we shall give them this opportunity.
 - 2) Use Visual Aids: Utilize picture charts, demonstration with dolls, or books to explain the process visually and encourage understanding.
- 3) Encourage Communication: Support your child in expressing their bathroom needs through words, signs, or pictures to facilitate effective communication.
- 4) Offer Reinforcers: Motivate your child with reinforcers like stickers, toys, or praise for attempting to use the toilet, reinforcing positive behaviour.

Remember, toilet training is a journey, and every child is unique. By being patient, consistent, and supportive, you can help your child master this milestone with confidence. Happy toilet training!
