Our Topics This Month

English: Introduction to phonetic sounds and identifying pictures associated with letters i, p, n, Classifying autumn words

Mathematics: Shapes- Rectangle and Triangle (2-D shapes) Introduction to the concept of numbers 3, 4 - counting, classifying, matching, comparing, and ordering.

Practical Life: Halloween, Pouring and transferring water from one jug to another and with a pipette, Rolling mats, Fire drills.
